Legal basis - Official control program

Order on the hygiene during milk production

Verordnung des EDI über die Hygiene bei der Milchproduktion (VHyMP)

vom 23. November 2005 (Stand am 1. Juni 2017)

Article 8 VHyMP:

Raw milk from cows must fulfil the following criteria:

SCC	<350'000	per ml, 30°C
ТВС	<80'000	per ml
Inhibitors	not detectable

Legal basis - Official control program

Geometric mean of 2 analyses per month

In case of non-compliance:

Injunction and milk delivery block

SCC 4th failure within 5 months

TBC 3rd failure within 4 months

Inhibitors Every failure



Legal basis – private control

Order on the control of raw milk

Milchprüfungsverordnung (MiPV)

916.351.0

vom 20. Oktober 2010 (Stand am 1. Mai 2017)

Article 8 MiPV:

The producers and processing organisations can agree on standard and binding price reductions or supplements for milk that does not meet or exceeds the hygiene requirements, respectively.



Private control - Extras



0.5 cents extra/kg if all of the following criteria are met:

- SCC ≤ 100'000 cells/ml
- TBC \leq 10'000 cfu/ml
- No inhibitors
- Freezing point ≤ -0.520°C



Private control – Reductions SCC/TBC

Reductions if TBC > 100'000 or SCC > 350'000 The worst result of the month is evaluated

Failures within 5 month	Reduction (cents)	
1st	1	
2nd	3	
3rd	6	
4th	12	
5th	24	Plus reception block until corrected



Private control – Reductions Inhibitors

Positive for inhibitors (within 12 months):

Failure	Reduction (cents)	
1st	10	plus effective costs
2nd	30	plus effective costs



Private control – Reductions Freezing Point

- Values between -0.520° C and -0.515° C: complaint
- Values ≥ -0.516° C: Price reductions according to milk sales contract



Further Agreements on reduced or extra payments

- Payment taking seasonality into account can be regulated in the milk sales contract
- Agreements on milk for cheese making, produced without silage
- Agreements for secondary milk purchasers
- Agreements for specific types of cheese
- Agreements for *labels*
